Seeking a Full Time and an "On call" Part time road crew worker.

Primary responsibilities for the Full Time worker would operate the equipment and provides the labor to maintain and repair the town highway system and associated equipment and facilities, including but not limited to road grading, trucking, snow plowing and sanding roads, brush clearing, road repair, light building maintenance and other assigned tasks. Must have a high school diploma, GED, or Trade School equivalent; a valid CDL driver's license, minimum Class B; be able to follow oral and written instructions; have the ability to deal in a courteous manner with the public; and have the strength and stamina to do manual labor and work in adverse weather conditions. Five years of progressive experience in roadway maintenance or related field preferred.

Position is generally 40 hours per week, Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Applicant must be willing to work after hours, holidays, and weekends when necessary. Salary and benefits, nonexempt position eligible for overtime. Bargaining unit position represented by United Steelworkers.

"On Call" road crew member would be available to work when contacted by the Road Foreman. Duties would include driving one ton truck, roadside mowing, running some equipment and helping other crew members with road maintenance as needed.
