TOWN OF DANBY, VERMONT ANNUAL MEETING 2023

The legal voters of the Town of Danby are hereby warned and notified to meet at Currier Memorial School, 234 North Main Street, Danby, Vermont on Monday, March 6, 2023 at 7:30 PM to transact the following business from the floor:

Article 1. Shall the voters accept the Town Report?

Article 2. Shall the voters authorize the payment of property taxes on or before November 15, 2023 by physical delivery to the Town Office before 3 p.m. on that date or by mail delivery to the Town Office postmarked on or before that date?

Article 3. Discuss the town budget and other articles to be voted on by Australian Ballot on March 7, 2023 at Danby Municipal Building.

Article 4. To transact any other business proper to come before this meeting.

The following to be voted on by Australian Ballot on Tuesday, March 7, 2023 at the Danby Municipal Building, 130 Brook Road, Danby, Vermont. Polls will be open from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM.

Article 5. To elect all Town Officers required by law:

- Town Moderator.....1 Year
- Selectboard Member.....2 Years
- Selectboard Member.....3 Years
- Town Clerk.....3 Years
- Town Treasurer.....3 Years
- Auditor..... 3 Years
- Trustee of Public Funds..... 3 Years
- Lister.....3 Years
- (2) Cemetery Commissioners....5 Years

Article 6. Shall the voters authorize total expenditures for operating expenses of \$ 1,333,306.00, of which \$1,091,896.00 shall be raised by taxes and \$241,410.00 by non-tax revenues for fiscal year July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024?

Article 7. Shall the town provide notice of the availability of the annual Town Report by postcard mailed to all registered voters at least 30 days before the annual Town Meeting, in lieu of mailing or otherwise distributing the Town Report, pursuant to 24 V.S.A. s 1682?



Shall the Town of Danby advise the Danby Select Board to adopt a Declaration of Inclusion as signed by Governor Phil Scott in 2021 to condemn discrimination in all of its forms and welcome all people in Vermont to live freely and express their opinions as stated in the proposed Town of Danby Declaration of Inclusion.
